What is the Franklin Pierce Educational Foundation?

The Franklin Pierce Educational Foundation (FPEF) was established in 2005 as a separate, non-profit organization to fund the financial aid needs of eligible Wake Christian Academy students. Since 2005, thanks to God and a core group of generous donors, the FPEF has seen the financial-aid endowment grow from \$90,000 to \$198,018. Today, the FPEF has set a goal to grow the financial-aid endowment to a level where the interest earned will fully fund the level of assistance given. The Annual Golf Tournament is the Foundation's primary fundraiser for the financial-aid endowment.
